

Training Announcement: Family Early Intervention Services



Family Early Intervention Services (Georgia PINES) is now accepting applications for training to become an early intervention specialist. This is a flexible contract opportunity that allows you to work on your own schedule after your regular work hours.

Early intervention Specialists (EISs) provide support and education to families of children from birth to 3 years old who are deaf/hard of hearing and/or blind/visually impaired, including children with multiple disabilities.

Training Details:

- Hybrid cohort model with monthly sessions from April 2026 through March 2027
- One required 2-day in-person session June 25 & 26, 2026 at MGSU in Macon
- \$150 registration fee and \$100 materials deposit fee (due by June 25, 2026)
- Potential of accepting service assignments starting August 1st, 2026.

Applicants must hold ONE of the following:

- Georgia Teaching Certificate
- Audiology License
- Speech and Language Pathologist License
- Program manager approved equivalent credentials
